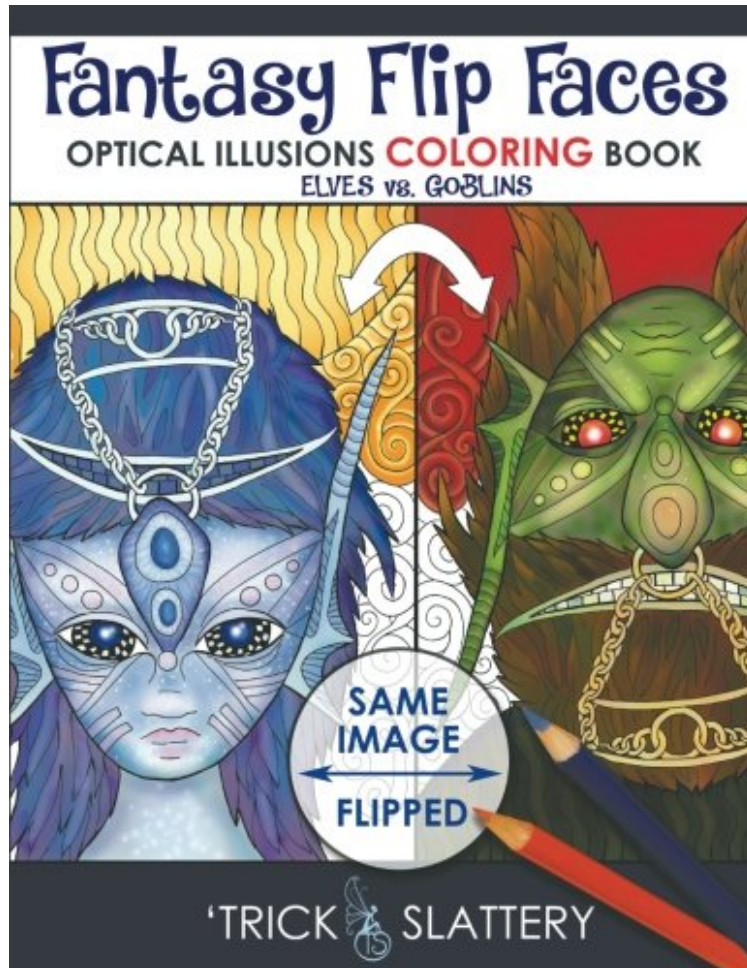

With a flip of the page, you have a new image to color. Each illustration can be colored twice. Same image-different view. This book is for the fantasy lover. Trick tells the story of an invisible world that humans cannot see called Terraflippia. It is a world filled with magic, elves, fairies, wizards, goblins, trolls, and other fantasy creatures. This world is a beautiful world, but it is also one that is divided. The two main factions of the world are the Elvenic, which consists of elves, unicorns and a grand wizard; and the Ganespe, which consists of goblins, trolls, imps, and others. He talks of the turmoil in Terraflippia caused by the division between the factions.....and about trying to find a solution to bring back the magic. The names of each creature are written in code. The included Elvenic Key will help decipher the names of each. This truly is a unique book. He has quite the imagination. The book has a nice, pleasing cover, showing one of his images partially colored in both views. At the beginning of the book are pages to put the colorists name, standard copyright information, and an information page that tells you a bit about the book. At the back of the book is a tester page to allow you to test your colors. It also lists his websites, where you can follow his work. This book contains 25 different illustrations just like this, and you get 2 of each so that you may color each view. There is no choosing or having to photocopy to color the alternate view. This is such an added bonus. The 2nd set is in the back half of the book. These are also drawn in his unique, quirky, and whimsical style. The image quality is clean and dark. There are no fuzzy, pixelated or skipped lines. The illustrations are full page with a white space border surrounding the images to allow for easy removal for framing. The images are single-sided, which is what colorists prefer. Paper weight is 60#, which is standard among most coloring books. You can use most coloring medium on this. If you use markers, you will need to put a couple blotter pages behind the image you are working on to prevent bleed through damage to the next page. If you prefer watercolor pencils, watercolors and other wet medium, you will need to photocopy to heavier paper that will hold up the the water application. I recommend watercolor paper, mixed media paper, or 110# weight card stock. The illustrations are quite detailed. For those with dexterity or vision issues, like myself, I don't believe you should have too much difficulty. While there are a few pages that do have some intricate areas that you may want to color individually, most of the smaller areas can be easily colored together with one color as a whole. Fantasy Flip Faces is an optical illusion coloring book that is filled with 25 elves, goblins, unicorns, wizards, dragons, trolls, and other fantasy creatures. Each illustration is printed twice for a total of 50 coloring pages. The book is 8 1/2" x 11", is glue bound, and all the images are single sided to minimize bleed through. I would recommend it for all ages and skill levels. My 5 year and 8 year old love it as well as all adults alike. Mediums I would recommend include colored pencils, crayons, markers, fine liners, and gel pens. All of the illustrations are optical illusions and can be seen in two different ways with the flip of the page. I just can't say enough good things about the book and it makes a great gift as well. All are drawn in "Tricks quirky and whimsical style. All illustrations can be seen in two ways with a flip of the page. The images were drawn with varying complexities, so if you are looking for a challenge you can choose a more intricate drawing with lots of nooks to color, or if you are looking for something quick or easy, a more simplistic page would be the way to go. Each illustration has been duplicated for a total of 50 coloring pages (duplicates in the back of the book), giving you a chance at a do-over or to color a different "view" of the same artwork. Coloring pages are single-sided to minimize bleed-through and scoring and have large margins for access to the entire image and ease of cutting out for framing. The wizard added the idea to an artist's thoughts prompting him to create a coloring book that

represents the two factions in 25 magical flip illustrations. The spell was placed on imagery that balances the two factions, and restores magic to Terraflippia. To the artist the coloring book and this story are just a part of his imagination, but to Terraflippia they are much more. The two factions on each page represent different sides of the same coin, and a balance between the two. The magic happens when humans around the globe access their creativity to give these illustrations the life of color. Now the magic is up to you. The views you see and the color you give to them have the capacity to save Terraflippia and bring peace. The grand wizard asks all colorists to color what is in their hearts, but also to remember that appearances aren't everything. What is ugly on the outside isn't always ugly on the inside. The fate of Terraflippia is in your hands! *****
