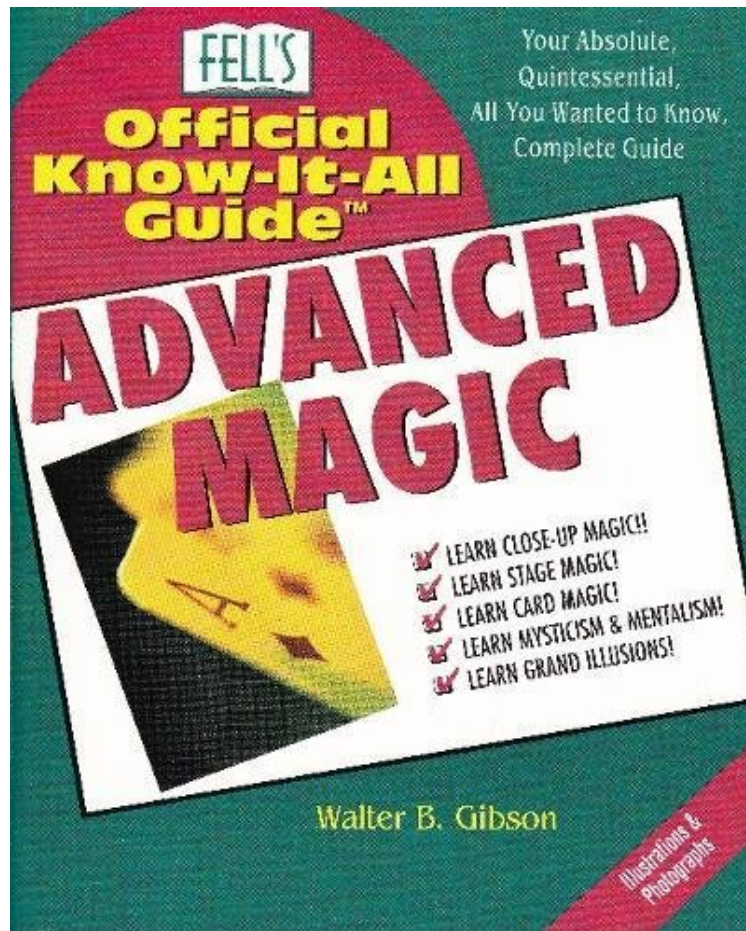

Walter Gibson author of most of The Shadow pulp novels was a prolific author. He wrote several books on magic. This volume is based on his book Mastering Magic and has been updated by editor Elia Ilan Chesnoff. It is hard to tell what is new and what not, aside from the obvious photographs and references to contemporary actors (Tom Cruise) or magicians (Lance Burton). The sections cover Close-Up Magic, Card Tricks, Stage Magic, Mentalism, Grand Illusions, and Historical Magic. The tricks are often covered in 1 to 1.5 pages. They are divided into Effect and Method. The first what the audience will see, and then how you actually do it. This book is for someone interested in the "how to" of magic. The stage magic and illusions will not provide you the detail to replicate the trick, but more an understanding of how it is done. For the close-up magic and card tricks, the instructions are sparse and require lots of practice to execute smoothly. About a third of the tricks have photographs or drawings to aid in the explanation of the

method. Fell's Advanced Magic introduces the budding amateur magician to a range of tricks and illusions.
