As someone with educational background in East Asian Studies and an instructor of Asian language, these cards are beautiful and inviting. The work is an excellent aesthetic match to someone with deep knowledge, respect /or understanding of Chinese history, mythology, culture, society and traditions--the elements composing card artwork. Functionally, in my short experience working with tarot divination tools, I've observed it is essential to have both cultural fit feel with the cards to enable reading accuracy and image interpretation by the reader. I would not recommend any cards to anyone who does not have an affinity for the artistic imagery or conceptualization context of the card design. Make sure you buy the bookBy J. G. MoralesThis is a very pretty deck. I was using the same deck for almost 7 years, and just decided to buy this one. I had a hard time finding a nice deck that had cards with telling images, that was as pretty and creative as my old deck, and also reasonably priced. After a lot of searching, this one seemed to be the best, and I am very pleased with my purchase.Make sure you buy the companion book for this deck. Otherwise, there will be a few things that could confuse even an experienced card reader.This deck uses White Tiger, Black Tortoise, Green Dragon, and Red Phoenix instead of Wands, Swords, Disks, and Cups. It also uses a "Transition" card instead of Death, etc. Although the little white book that comes with the cards tells you that White Tiger is the same as Swords, for example, the meanings of the cards and the use of Feng Shui principles, etc. is not fully explained.Additionally, what would be wands and fire in this deck is actually black tortoise and water. What would be cups is instead fire. This is one thing I'm finding a little confusion in making the switch to this new deck. Working with this deck is going to take a little time getting used to, considering the differences. However, it is a very lovely deck, so I don't mind the trouble.0 of 0 people found the following review helpful. The Feng Shui Tarot deck combines the traditional elements of tarot with the ancient Chinese wisdom, spiritual belief, and principles of Form School Feng Shui (balancing environment, surroundings, materials, and colors.) Feng Shui is based on the philosophy that the flow of energy (or "chi") can be directed in certain ways by optimal placement of items large and small to balance yin and yang, thus creating a more favorable environment for the people in that space. This remarkable deck is designed to give a tarot reading with the meanings of the cards delineated by beautiful visual images of Feng Shui.
