Not a great guide, but for the cheap price, it also isn't terrible.By TheoStixOk, this isn't a great guide, but for the cheap price (you can get a used copy for \$4), it does give you a completely adequate walkthrough of the main storyline of the game and some of the side-missions....Pros...-Well-written for the most part. The author Andrew Vestal was obviously passionate about the project, and it shows. While the general walkthrough bits are generally sparse and simply just short, concise step-by-step instructions ("Walk here, talk to this NPC, click this button", etc.) there is a lot of charm to some of the other sections, and his descriptions of characters, settings, etc. is quite nice.-Good quality for cheap price. From an assembly and aesthetic perspective, the book is very sturdy, and of a high quality, easily comparable to the more official guides available on the market.

(Heck, my copy is actually in BETTER condition than most of the "Official" strategy guides I own, despite going through similar use and wear-and-tear.)-It gets the job done on a budget. With this guide, you'll get through the game and be able to conquer most of the side-quests quite easily at a fraction of the cost of the official guides. (Especially now, when older guides costs more due to their being out-of-print and rarer.)...Cons...-The lack of pictures and the fact that some sections feel inaccurate at times does make it hard to follow on the rare occasion.-Some content is still missing, from what I can tell.This was the guide I was given in 2000 when I got "Final Fantasy VIII" for my birthday, and it helped me get through the game quite easily and painlessly. I might have nostalgia goggles on because this was the guide I grew up with (I never got the official guide until only recently, when I saw it on sale, being phased out at a store trying to liquidate older merchandise to make room for new things), but I would say that it's at least worth checking out.
