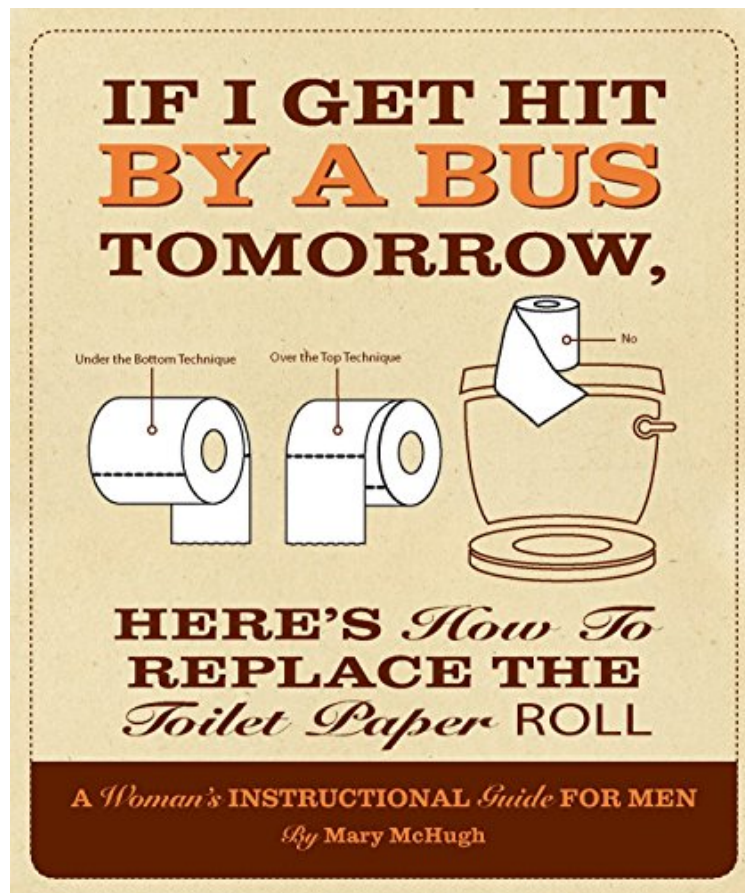


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If I Get Hit by a Bus Tomorrow, Here's How to Replace the Toilet Paper Roll: A Woman's Instructional Guide for Men
