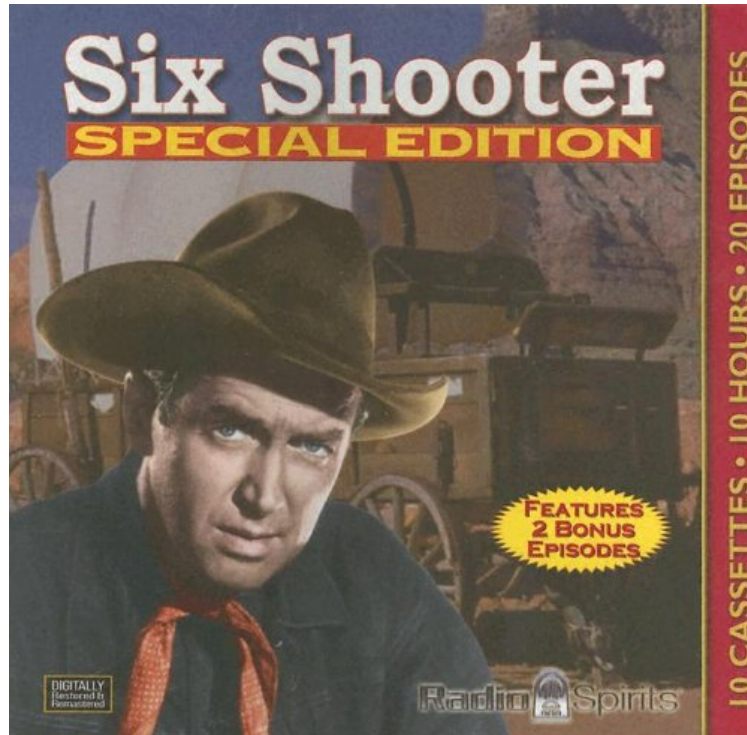

Created by Frank Burt, it came sort of late in the radio era, but in 1953-1954 James Stewart starred as Britt Ponset, an unassuming cowboy who never sought out trouble, but left a trail of still-remembered legends as he wandered from Texas across the Western Plains. So good was he at handling trouble, and a gun, Ponset became known as The Six Shooter. Stewart was terrific as the regular fellow townsfolk along the trail came to depend on whenever there was trouble. He had many friends, and his easygoing manner often put him in humorous situations. It was one of the strengths of this show which differed from others of its ilk. Stewart's performances were pitch-perfect, as he brought the same charm and regular fellow persona he held in films. There is plenty here for western fans to enjoy, but some of the best entries sprung from Stewart's laconic portrayal of Ponset. One of the best shows, for instance, Battle at Tower Rock, has Britt wandering into town and getting tricked into judging the yearly strawberry preserve contest between two feuding sisters. Stewart makes it hilarious as he tries to find a way out of the jam! One of the two bonus episodes on this 20 show, 10 hour collection, The New Sheriff, has Britt once again being roped into something. This time it's running for Sheriff. Stewart once again squirms his way to a solution with some fine humor sprinkled along the way. There is plenty of danger, old-west style, along the trail as Ponset becomes known for his honesty and his gun. Those who enjoy old radio won't be disappointed by this one. Join the tall angular Britt Ponsit for a ride through small towns along the trail and have a good time. The Six Shooter is

definitely one of the best radio shows from the era.
