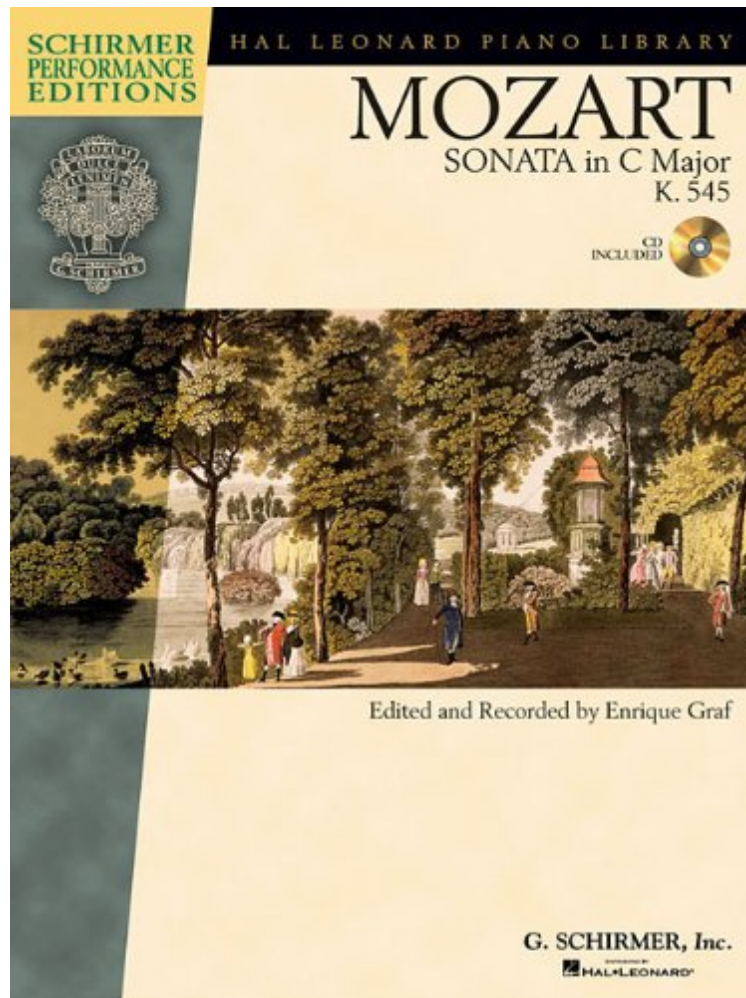

2 of 2 people found the following review helpful. Don't buy this. By Richard Sears The format is spread out so more page turning is needed. Also, I actually find it more difficult to read than a traditional format. Fingering is sparse at best. However the worst issue is the broken cords in the left hand in measures 18 through 21. They are written spread across the bass and treble staves which I find extremely difficult to read. More traditional formats simply change the bass staff to treble for these measures making the broken cords intuitive. I found the traditional format easy to play through for the first time while I simply get stymied by the difficulty of reading Graf's version. When things are not broken, they do not need fixing, this edition does not bring anything much to the table.
